#### IB DIPLOMA PROGRAM @ NOBLESSE

Noblesse will begin offering the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program to grade 11 students in August 2013. Students currently in grade 10 are now selecting their courses.

All IB students take the following classes:

1.	Theory of Knowledge	3hrs/wk
2.	Extended Essay (research project)	3hrs/wk

**Community-Action-Service (Community Service projects)** 

In addition, students will make the following selections:

4.	English OR Korean Language & Literature (1st language)	6hrs/wk
5.	English OR Chinese 2 <sup>nd</sup> Language	4hrs/wk
6.	Business Management	6hrs/wk
7.	Physics OR Biology	6hrs/wk
8.	Mathematics	4hrs/wk
9.	Art OR Music OR Computer Science	4hrs/wk

#### WHAT IS COMMUNITY-ACTION-SERVICE (CAS)?

Creativity, action, service is at the heart of the Diploma programme, involving students in a range of activities that take place alongside their academic studies throughout the IB Diploma Programme. The component's three strands, often interwoven with particular activities, are characterized as follows:

- Creativity arts and other experiences that involve creative thinking
- Action physical exertion contributing to a healthy lifestyle, complementing academic work elsewhere in the IB Diploma Programme
- Service an unpaid and voluntary exchange that has a learning benefit for the student.

### PROMOTION POLICY

Students who fail one or two subjects (end-of-year average) must sit for make-up exams in August ... OR attend a Summer School Program ... before being permitted to begin the next grade level. Proof of attendance at a non-NIS Summer Program must be provided.

Students who fail three or more subjects (end-of-year average) must repeat the grade level OR attend Summer School and pass make-up exams administered in the failing subjects in August.

#### NIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Application Forms are now available on our website and at Reception for our Scholarship Program for the 2013-14 school year. Three types of scholarships will be awarded (see below). Applications must include supporting evidence (report cards, certificates, etc), and will be reviewed by the School Board in early July. Recipients will be notified in mid-July.

- 1. Academic (6-12<sup>th</sup> students with a high over-overall average)
  - a. 93-94% = 10% discount
  - b. 95-96% = 25% discount
  - c. 97-100% = 50% discount
- Athletic (local, regional, national level)
- Performing Arts (local, regional, national level)
